## Schedule of Events & Meet Information

### SUNDAY, June 17—Welcome

- Hotel Check In & Registration. Traditional evening meet & greet with ice cream social at Hotel.

### MONDAY, June 18—Green Bay and Pulaski

- Drive to the National Railroad Museum. Tour exhibits, including Eisenhower's Command Car.
- Drive to Chase Stone Barn; lunch provided.
- Drive to Marquis / Carver Yacht manufacturing facility for tour.
- Dinner on your own.

### TUESDAY, June 19—Green Bay

- Drive to Kaukauna along the Fox River. The Fox River had been a working river, utilized by French explorers and used for much of the 19th and 20th centuries as a source of power and transportation. At one time, 24 paper mills were dependent upon the river, the highest concentration in the world. A lock and dam system allowed use for early transportation. In early colonization and before, the river had been connected to the Wisconsin River via a canal in Portage, WI. Fort Howard was built on the riverbank during the War of 1812 to protect the Fox-Wisconsin waterway. The fort was built in what became the City of Green Bay. It was staffed off and on to 1841, then decommissioned and dismantled. Buildings from the fort have been reconstructed at Heritage Hill State Park.
- Drive to Green Bay Packaging's Folding Carton Division. Tour a world leader in design and high speed manufacturing of retail packages.
- Drive to The Automobile Gallery. The gallery was established to highlight the automobile as art, while providing space for public utilization. It was conceived by local businessman "Red" Lewis, and built by him in a former Cadillac dealership. After a foundation was established to manage the gallery, it was given to the community. Many of the cars were provided by "Red," but others have been donated, with additional rotating displays. Lunch will be provided at The Automobile Gallery.
- Afternoon options on your own. Maps will be provided for: Heritage Hill State Park, Packer Stadium Tour, Green Bay Botanical Gardens, Tiletown Brewery Tour
- Dinner on your own.

### WEDNESDAY, June 20—Manitowoc

- Drive to Wisconsin Maritime Museum. Tour a restored WWII submarine, the USS Cobia, and view exhibits related to early Lake Michigan activities. A world-recognized model ship display is also located at the museum.
- Drive along Lake Michigan to Neshota Park, Two Rivers. Lunch provided.
- Drive to Hamilton Wood Type & Printing Museum, Two Rivers. Tour the only museum dedicated to the preservation of wood type, formerly manufactured by Hamilton.
- Dinner on your own.

### THURSDAY, June 21—Hartford and Oshkosh

- Board buses to take us to Wisconsin Automotive Museum. Exhibits include a number of rare Kissel Kars, which were manufactured in Hartford. Nash, also manufactured in Wisconsin, is represented as well.
- Lunch provided.
- Bus to Experimental Aircraft Association Museum, Oshkosh. Exhibits include war birds, experimental, antique, and classic airplanes, plus SpaceShipOne.
- Dinner on your own.

### FRIDAY, June 22—Tech session, Swap Meet, Car show, Banquet at the hotel

- Lunch on your own at hotel.
- **Option**—Bus to Door County for shopping. Travel to Door County, offering specialty stores that can delight all tastes.
